The depleted combat soldiers are given medical attention, food, fresh clothing and an opportunity to get cleaned up, rest and recuperate.

Similarly, on August 21st, the Pittsburgh community will come together to host Stand Down 2010, an intensive service fair for homeless veterans and their families, offering a daylong respite from the streets and a real opportunity for individuals to put their lives back together.
